The Foundation Stone was laid by the PGM, Rt.W.Bro.David Malcolm Wheeler at the N.E.Corner of the building on Monday 5th August 2019 and the external building is now complete with the roof, windows, external fire doors, porch and pillars in place. The Concrete floor has been poured, interior work with the first fix electrics and HVAC system completed and plastering progressing well. Brethren, we now need to concentrate on the internal work and fixings. for which finance is a now a priority to be able to complete the work to a standard as befitting our new centre. Please consider getting on board with a Founders Brick.

We therefore plan to set aside a section of the reception/bar area (north east corner) where we can place

100 or more engraved "Founders Bricks."

The bricks will be sold for £500 each, each brother able to buy **one** brick, engraved with their name should they so wish.

Payment can be a one off sum, please make cheques out to Lindsey and Hermes Lodge Benevolent Fund Or bank transfer to sort code 40-30-26 account 21313487 please use your name as reference, or the Trustees have agreed the cost can be spread, over twelve monthly, 1 x payment of £60 followed by 11 x payments of £40, or over twenty five months, 25 x payments of £20 a month, equating to just £5 per week.

Of course, if any brother wishes to give more than the price of a brick towards the new Masonic Centre, the trustees will be pleased to receive any special donation for a piece of new furniture or fitting. Please contact either myself or the Treasurer John Truss in confidence.

We hope that you will agree this will not only raise much needed funds to make our new centre special but will show visitors for many years into the future the commitment and drive of our generation of Freemasons.
