

## Section II. State Support

Household Circumstance	Paperwork Required
<b>Pensioner</b>	Aged 65 and over → State Pension (SP) and/or Pension Credit (PC)
<b>Employed / Self Employed with a low income</b>	Check whether they are entitled to receive Working Tax Credits (WTC)
<b>Employed and Unable to Work Due to Illness</b>	First 28 weeks of unemployment → Statutory Sick pay (SSP) 29 weeks onwards of unemployment → Employment Support Allowance (ESA) Medical certificate → Employment Support Allowance (ESA)
<b>Unemployed and Able to Work</b>	Job Seeker's Allowance (JSA)
<b>Parent or Guardian</b>	One or both: Child Tax Credits (CTC) Child Benefit (CB)
<b>Applicant is a Carer</b>	Carer's Allowance (CA). This is paid to the Applicant directly. Income Support (IS)
<b>Disability, Mobility Issues and Personal Care</b>	Aged 16 and under → Disability Living Allowance (DLA) Aged 16 to 65 inclusive → Personal Independence Payment (PIP) Aged over 65 → Attendance Allowance (AA)
<b>Housing Adaptation</b>	Disabled Facilities Grant (DFG)
<b>Housing Costs</b>	One of the following: Housing Benefits (HB) Council Tax Support (CTS) Council Tax Reduction (CTR) Support for Mortgage Interest (SMI)
<b>Bereaved</b>	Possible Entitlements to: Bereavement Allowance (BA) Bereavement Payment (BP) Widowed Parents Allowance (WPA) Funeral Grants/Assistance
